

## **Caterpillar Patterns**

Make a caterpillar pattern to wear as a hat.

## What to do

## What you need

- Construction paper strips
- Caterpillar Face Outline
- 6 Circle Outlines
- Scissors

Stapler

- Cut out a caterpillar face.
- Select the colors you want to use to make a pattern.
- Cut out 6-8 circles to make your pattern. What pattern did you make?
- Arranging the circles into your pattern (example, blue, green, blue, green).
- Make a headband with the construction paper strips to fit around your head.
- Staple the caterpillar face to the headband.
- 7 Staple the circles onto the headband to form your caterpillar pattern. Now you're ready to wear your caterpillar hat!

## **For Parents**

Patterns are everywhere in the world. They are an important part of understanding math relationships and counting. When making and describing a pattern, your child is expanding his or her understanding of what patterns are. Try making another caterpillar with the same colors but different pattern. Try making a more complex pattern.
