Sticky Shapes

Play a game to guess the sticky shapes.

What to do

What you need

- 2 players
- Contact paper
- Shape cards
- Assorted Craft Items

1

Set the shape cards face down in a pile.

2

Player 1 selects a shape card, but does not show the card to the other player.

3

Player 1 describes the shape to the other player. *How many sides, corners, lines, etc. does the shape have?*

4

Player 2 makes the shape with the materials provided on the contact paper and says the name of the shape.

5

Players take turns trying to guess the shape being described until all the cards have been used. *How many shapes can you guess correctly?*

For Parents

This game helps identify shapes. Encourage your child to look for shapes as you go shopping or during car rides. Ask your child questions about shapes he/she sees. What makes the shape a triangle? How is it different from a rectangle? What's the difference between a circle and an oval?
