What You Do

- 1. Invite a child or a small group of children to find an object in the classroom that matches your simple description, e.g., "Please find me a ball."
- Hold an infant and find the object with him. Take a toddler's hand and walk around the room with her, asking questions to support her search.
- 3. Describe the objects children find, e.g., "Jaize, you brought me an orange from our pretend area. Yes, this orange is round like a ball!"

- Count the objects in the collection, pointing to each object as you count.
- For older twos, increase the complexity of the description,
 e.g., "Please find me something that has stripes."
