What You Do

- 1. Invite children to stand or sit in a circle with you.
- 2. Play a rhythm instrument as you sing the following to the tune of "The Mulberry Bush."
 - This is the way we take a turn, take a turn, take a turn,
 - This is the way we take a turn and pass it to the left.
- As you sing, encourage children to use the instrument briefly and then pass it to the left so it continues around the circle.

- Give each child a rhythm instrument as you sing. After each verse, encourage the children to pass their instruments.
- Demonstrate how to pass the instrument to the right and to the left, and then ask children to listen to the song to find out which direction to follow.
- Invite children to suggest interesting ways to pass the instrument, e.g., over their heads, under their knees, behind their backs, etc.
- Invite children to create a pattern as they pass the instrument, e.g., pass it high, pass it low, pass it high, pass it low.
