What You Do

- 1. Say,** “I don't want to forget anything! Let's make sure we have everything we need.”
- 2. Ask the children,** “Did you remember your [ears]?” **filling in the blank with different body parts.**
- 3. Encourage the children to touch each body part as you name it and respond “yes” or “no.”**

- **As you call out each body part, sketch and label the body part on a sheet of chart paper. Invite the children to direct where you sketch the body parts and identify the beginning letter sound.**
- **Include silly questions such as,**
“Did you remember your...
tail?”
horns?”
beak?”
trunk?”
