



Family School Partnerships / Introducing ReadyRosie

OVERVIEW

Family involvement is critical to the success of children. Parents want to be involved but many times are not sure how to support their child. Successful implementation of ReadyRosie is dependent on the support and excitement of the families. This 10-minute introduction to ReadyRosie is intended to be shown to parents at the beginning of the year or before you begin using ReadyRosie. It may be given in large groups like Meet the Teacher, Back to School Night, Open House or can be shown to individual parents at the first parent teacher conference.

INTENDED TIMEFRAME:

This is a 10-minute interactive introduction that can be delivered at any gathering of families to explain what ReadyRosie is.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Participants will:

- » Be introduced to ReadyRosie as an ongoing tool that provides rich learning content and activities.
- » Experience a ReadyRosie learning game that they can play with their child.
- » Register to receive the ReadyRosie content if they haven't already.

Welcome and Introduction - 1 Minute

ACTIVITY

Welcome families and introduce yourself.

Have families quickly introduce themselves. NOTE: Make sure this moves quickly.

ASK

What if you could have a tool of developmentally appropriate activities, expert videos to answer your questions, and a way to communicate with your child's teacher? Thumbs up if you would love that!

STATE

Parenting doesn't come with instructions. Every parent wants to know what to do, are we doing it right? It can be stressful and we all look for answers to our parenting questions.

KEY POINTS

Share that you are excited about using the family partnership tool, ReadyRosie. Explain that by using ReadyRosie they will have free access to the rich educational games and tools that support language/reading skills, mathematical thinking, social emotional learning, and healthy routines so their families and children are successful at learning.

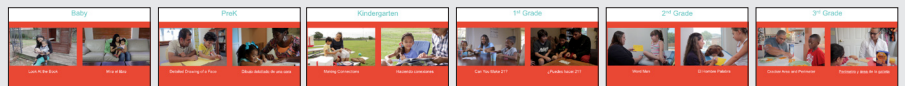
KEY POINTS

Registration

1. Give us your mobile phone number and/or email.
2. Accept the invitation to begin receiving content.

Registration

1. Take out your phone.
2. Check to see if you have an email or text.
3. If not check your spam.
4. Accept invitation.

NEXT STEPS

1. Once you sign up you will get learning games and activities like this one to do with your child. You can also search for and find learning games and parenting content that are specific to things you want to know about and try with your child.
2. **NOTE: Choose the option that fits your situation.**

OPTION #1
